Members Participating in Golf Association Events

Unlimited Members are eligible to compete in the Golf Association Events and will only owe the Event Fee to participate in each event.

Limited Members are eligible to compete in the Golf Association Events after the Limited Member pays a One-Time per year Golf Association Play-In Fee prior to the first event they play in, and then will owe the Event Fee to participate in each event. If a Limited Member wants to avoid paying this extra fee, then the individual will need to become an Unlimited Member. The 2024 Limited Member, is required to pay a One-Time per year Golf Association Play-In Fee is \$100 and can be paid online at your Home Courses Online Store.

Golf Association Events are for Unlimited and Limited Members. A player that has a Junior Membership (Age 12-17) does not qualify to participate in the Golf Association Events.

Both Men & Women are eligible to compete in the Golf Association Events. Men (59 and under), Seniors (60 and over), and Women will play different tees, all for the same purse (some events may play the same set of tees for all players). Handicaps will be adjusted accordingly. If you see the term “Junior” it will mean age 59 and younger. When you see “Senior” it will mean age 60 and over. Should a female play in an event, they will be subject to playing from the tees the Junior or Senior group will play from (there will be some events that women will play from a lady’s tee, different than the Junior or Senior group will be playing from).

Collective Cup

The Collective Cup is the end of the year golf association event, which is an event that only members that qualify will participate in. Throughout the year, a player will earn Collective Cup Points for participation and extra points for how they finish up in the event. Each course will have 8 members and their home course Head Golf Professional battle in a 1-day event. The best 6 scores of the 9 players on each team, per hole, after handicap, will be counted. The final team scores are always very close every year.

New for 2024 - Each Course will now have 8 members participate in the Collective Cup. There are 4 spots that will receive an automatic bid to the Collective Cup per course including: Winner of the Junior Handicap Division Match Play, Winner of the Senior Handicap Division Match Play, Winner of the Junior Handicap Division Individual Stroke Play, and Winner of the Senior Handicap Division Individual Stroke Play. These winners must participate in at least 50% of the 2024 Golf Association Events in order to get this automatic bid to the Collective Cup. The remaining 4 spots per team, will be the Top 4 Collective Cup Point earners that do not have an automatic bid to the final event. Yes, there is a chance that someone could win both the Match Play and Stroke Play events. If this happens, then only 3 people would have automatic bids and the Top 5 Collective Cup Point earners will qualify for the end of the year event.

Please note, that the Match Play and Individual Stroke Play Events will be held at a Members Home Course. This will make way for more people to say, I am the winner of something at my home course! We all take great pride in winning. Now you will have the opportunity to win more and be proud of your home club!

Event Registration Process

Registration for each event will happen at the Course's website the event is being held at. The first event of the year will be the 1-Player Scramble at the Golf Club of Dublin on Sunday, April 7th. The registration deadline is Sunday, March 31st at 9:00pm. Since this event is held at the Golf Club of Dublin, you will register at the Golf Club of Dublin's website. For the Match Play and Stroke Play Events, these are held at each course. The Home Course you selected for your 2024 Golf Membership when you purchased your membership, is the Home Course you will play at for these events. For example, if your home course is New Albany Links, you will play in the Match Play at NAL and Stroke Play at NAL. If your home course is the Golf Club of Dublin, you will play in the Match Play at GCD and Stroke Play at GCD.

Registration Deadlines are at 9:00pm on the Sunday prior to an event. The Stroke Play Registration is about 2 weeks prior to the event, so make sure you register before the Sunday, June 30th Deadline.

To register for an Event, you will go to the golf courses website, click on the “Store” at the home page screen or click on the menu button in the top right corner of the page and choose “Online Store”. Once you get to this point, select the menu for “Golf Members Only – KSCC Golf Association Events”. Then select the event you want to register for. Please note that this process may be different on a phone or tablet compared to a computer screen.

Handicap Reminders & Score Posting

All Members are expected to post their score following their round of golf. This can be done using the GHIN Golf App or online at www.GHIN.com. Most people will use the GHIN Handicap App on their phones.

The Ohio Golf Association determines the “In-Season” and “Out of Season” time periods as to when scores are to be posted. To get your GHIN activated, please contact your Home Course Golf Shop Staff (Unlimited & Limited Members get the GHIN for included in their memberships).

Active Season for Posting Scores in Ohio: March 15th to November 30th

This year the Tournament Director, Tournament Committee, and Golf Staff will be randomly reviewing daily score posting. We will compare the tee sheet with scores posted for that day. If you have any questions or concerns regarding handicaps, please contact the Tournament Director or your Home Courses Tournament Committee Member.

The best way to figure out your Course Handicap or golfers you are playing with, is to use the GHIN App. Open the App, click on “Course Handicap Calculator”, enter the “Golf Course Name”, select the number of holes to be played, click “Select Golfers”, pick the golfers from your list or add golfers to this using the search bar, click “Add Golfers”, change the tees in which each golfer is playing, then each golfers Course Handicap (CH) will be available. Once you do this a few times it will all make sense. It is a very handy tool built in the GHIN App.

Golf Association: Individual Match Play

(Course Specific & Season Long)

- Start Date** Matches may begin on Wednesday, May 1st
- Course** Home Course for the Member
- Times** Players are responsible to set the date and time of each match. If a match has not been played within the allotted time, a coin toss will determine the match winner.
- Entry Fee** \$40 per player (1 division per person)

Format

- Match Play. Handicaps will be played off of the lower ball in the match where applicable. The higher handicapped player will receive the full difference in course handicap between the two players; the lower handicapped player will play from scratch.
- Example: If Player A is a 10 handicap and Player B is a 6 handicap, 10-6=4. So, Player A’s Handicap for the match will be 4. Therefore, Player A will receive 1 stroke on the 4 hardest holes.
- All matches for a Match Play Event will be held at the Course in which the Event is at (a Members Home Course is the course’s match play event they will participate in).
- Default Number of Holes: A match is to be played in an 18-hole match. But if players agree to play a 9-hole match, or another set of holes for their match, that is fine. Just as long as both players agree on the number of holes to be played. If the match is tied at the completion of 18 holes, continue in a playoff, one hole at a time until someone wins the match.
- Participation Points are given to players who compete in at least 1 match. Should someone register for the event and not compete, they will not receive the participation points for the event.
- Each Division will play the same set of tees for all players playing in that division. Should a female play in the event, they will play 1 tee marker forward.
- A player can earn points for each match won. No points if a player gets a bye in Round 1 of the match play bracket.

Format

- Modified 4-Player Scramble. Sign up as an Individual. Specify teammates at registration.
- All players will hit their tee shot, like a normal scramble. From there, the team will take the best two tee shots and pair off into 2-player teams (must keep the same 2-player teams until that hole is completed). If your shot is selected off the tee, then you must play from that point and have another teammate join your 2-player team scramble that hole. Each team will finish the hole in a scramble format. The team will have 2 scores per hole. It is up to the 4-Player team as to what the 2-Player teams are each hole, and the teams can change each hole if they desire.
- \$80 Optional Team Gross Skins: Lowest combined total per hole
- Flights are determined by the number of groups signed up for the event, Handicapped Event
- Tees: Men – Blue, Senior (60+) – White, Women – Red (*tees are subject to change*)

- Junior is age 59 and under and Senior is age 60 and over, as of the day of the event.
- Front Nine (holes 1-9) is a Modified Alternate Shot and Back Nine (holes 10-18) is a Scramble. For the modified alternate shot format, each player will tee off, the team selects the best shot to take, and the players shot taken, will not hit the 2nd shot, the partner will, and then alternate back and forth until the hole is completed.
- \$40 Optional Gross Skins Game per team (low gross score per hole)
- Tees: Men – Blue, Senior (60+) – Gold, Women – Silver *(tees are subject to change)*

Handicaps

- Both Members must have an active USGA GHIN Handicap Index to participate, no exceptions. Handicaps will be calculated by taking 50% of the teams’ total handicap (handicap calculation is subject to change)
